P4 Learning Journey to National Gallery Singapore – Museum-Based Learning for Art Education

As part of a compulsory module of Art education, we are organising an educational Learning Journey to the National Gallery Singapore for our P4 students on the following dates: 9, 10, 11, 16 and 17 July 2025.

The objectives of the learning journey are to:

- Understand the museum as a custodian of Singapore's culture and heritage.
- Learn about Singapore art as part of all Primary 4 students' core learning experience of the MOE Art syllabus.
- Participate in Museum-Based Learning activities that facilitate observation and inquiry into selected local artworks.

The National Gallery has requested that our students avoid bringing bags, as they will only be allowed to carry a pencil and their activity sheets during their visit. All other belongings will be placed in museum lockers for safekeeping during the tour.

Students will have lunch from 11.30 a.m. to 12 noon to ensure that they have sufficient time for a proper meal before leaving school.

Kindly make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward upon his/her return at 3.45 p.m.

- 17 July 2025, Thursday – P4 Tenacity

Students will follow normal school reporting time (7:30 a.m.) and timetabled lessons will continue until 11.30 a.m. Dismissal time will be 3.45 p.m.

Students will leave their school bags in school and bring only a small bag with them on the learning journey.
